Infertility Conditions: Understanding the Causes and Impact



Infertility is a condition of the male or female reproductive system, defined by the failure to achieve a pregnancy after 12 months or more of regular unprotected sexual intercourse. It affects millions of people worldwide, with approximately one in every six people of reproductive age experiencing infertility in their lifetime.



Causes of Infertility

Infertility affects both men and women equally, with each gender accounting for approximately 30% of cases. A combination of factors from both partners is responsible for another 30% of infertility cases, while the cause remains unknown in 10% of cases.

Symptoms of Male Factor Sub-Fertility

- Low sperm count or poor sperm quality
- · Erectile dysfunction or ejaculation problems
- Hormonal imbalances or genetic disorders
- Infections or inflammation of the reproductive tract
- Varicoceles or other anatomical abnormalities
- Previous injuries or surgeries affecting fertility

Problem in the male reproductive

system: Infertility can be caused by problems in the ejection of semen, absence or low levels of sperm or abnormal shape and movement of the sperm.

Male Factor Infertility

Male infertility can be caused by obstruction of the reproductive tract, hormonal disorders, testicular failure and abnormal sperm function and quality. These can include blockages in the tubes that carry semen, hormonal imbalances, varicoceles and abnormal sperm shape and movement.

Problem in the female reproductive

system: infertility may be caused by a range of abnormalities of the ovaries, uterus, fallopian tubes and the endocrine system.


Female Factor Infertility

Female infertility can be caused by tubal disorders, uterine disorders, ovarian disorders and endocrine system disorders. These can include blocked fallopian tubes, endometriosis, polycystic ovarian syndrome and hormonal imbalances.



Symptoms of Female Factor Sub-Fertility

- · Irregular or absent menstrual cycles
- · Pelvic pain or heavy bleeding during periods
- Endometriosis or polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS)
- · Blocked or damaged fallopian tubes
- Ovarian cysts or fibroids
- Hormonal imbalances or thyroid disorders
- Previous miscarriages or failed fertility treatments

Lifestyle Factors and Environmental Toxins

Lifestyle factors such as stress, smoking, excessive alcohol intake and obesity can affect fertility. Exposure to environmental pollutants and toxins can also negatively impact fertility.

Unexplained Infertility

Unexplained infertility is a diagnosis given when a fertility specialist cannot identify a specific cause of infertility after comprehensive testing and evaluation of a couple or individual. This diagnosis is given when the woman's fallopian tubes and ovulation are normal and the man has healthy sperm.
